

ASKING FOR & GIVING DIRECTIONS VIDEO

Number of group members: Min. 2 people / Max. 4 people

Format: Video recording. Have you ever become an actor/actress? This is your opportunity! Do a role-play and record yourself!

Duration: Approximately 5 min

TOPIC:

Every year there are plenty of foreigners coming to our town, they get lost and need help from us. In this project, you will have the opportunity to perform a situation like this. Divide your group into tourists and locals. The tourist has just come to Conil and wants to get to different points. The other member/s are local and must help the foreigner to arrive at those places.

PROCESS

- 1) **Assign one CHARACTER for each member of the group.** Each member must have a role and his/her part of conversation. Distribute the **different roles equally** (similar length of talk).
- 2) **Design the DIALOGUE.** Decide the starting point in Conil and the different places the tourist wants to go. Make sure to use the **vocabulary learnt** (directions, places) and **grammar** (some conditionals). You have a model of the dialogue we did in the classroom but make it **longer and real**, adapted to our town, Conil. Also you can **include some talk about the culture** that the tourist is interested in knowing and ask the local.
- 3) **Decide the WARDROBE for each member and the PLACES where you are going to record.** Make sure the places are quiet, and your voice can be heard easily.
- 4) **PRACTISE the dialogue.** Every performance requires rehearsal before being published. Learn your part and take care of your discourse (seem natural and attractive, not boring), pronunciation, intonation and body position.
- 5) **Record!** With a camera or your mobile phone, but make sure you can save it in a pen later!
- 6) **Hand in!** Save your file in the folder SPEAKING-2nd TERM of your classroom computer before the 14th of March.
